She also serves as non-executive director for Broadway Living, a wholly owned subsidiary of Ealing Council.

Pocket Living delivers grant-free affordable homes that can be purchased at a 20% discount for people with moderate incomes. The company offers affordable homes for first-time buyers at Addiscombe Grove in Croydon and Harbard Close in Barking.
